The Ambitious about Autism Schools Trust supports new special schools, like The Rise School, to help children and young people with autism to learn, do well and achieve.

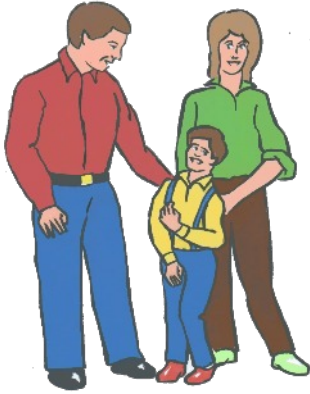

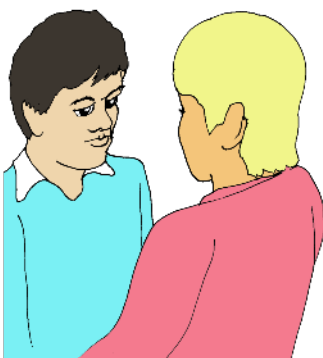

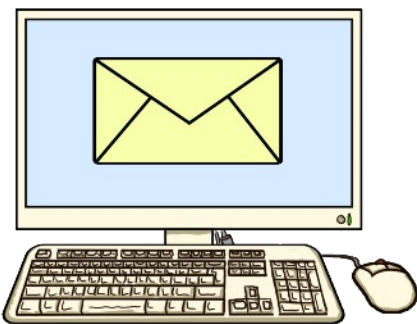
